

NASBHC Guidelines and Procedure for State Affiliate Applicants

NASBHC and its State Affiliates strive to build a strong national organization with a network of strong State Affiliates representing and working on behalf of children, adolescents, their families and school-based health care.

NASBHC will identify only one affiliate per state. Organization's interested in becoming a State Affiliate shall submit a letter of intent and the requested materials to the Executive Director (email to Alicia Newell at anewell@nasbhc.org).

NASBHC will review and consider the material based on its alignment with NASBHC's vision, mission and strategic goals. Organizations will be notified within 30 days. Organizations that meet the criteria will be sent an Affiliation Agreement to sign and an invoice for Organizational Membership (\$500) required of all State Affiliates.

Requested materials:

An organization interested in becoming a NASBHC State Affiliate must demonstrate organizational capacity and a state-wide focus. Interested organizations shall submit the following:

1. Mission/vision statement
2. List of Board/Advisory Board members
3. Strategic plan
4. List of donors
5. Letters of support from 50% of the SBHC programs in the state or ten (10) SBHCs, whichever is fewer.
6. References from three (3) strategic partners, with at least one from a state-level partner.
